tips

Don't worry about boxing your groceries. Our team will do that for you.

Don't worry about getting it perfect. If an item on the list isn't available, replace it with something similar (e.g. substitute pasta for egg noodles).

When items are available in multiple sizes (e.g. peanut butter), choose larger sizes if possible.

If you buy bread in advance, freeze it until the drop-off date.

If you purchase enough food for multiple boxes, please keep them separated.

list of items.

Instant oatmeal

2 boxes of breakfast bars

1 loaf of bread, or pack of tortillas, or pack of buns

Peanut butter or cheese crackers

Pudding cups

Fruit cups

2 cans of beans
(black, kidney)

2 cans of veggies
(corn, peas, green beans, etc.)

2 cans of beef ravioli or chili

2 cans hearty/chunky soup

Large box (or 2 small boxes) of instant rice

2 packs of microwaveable mac and cheese

2 jars/cans of pasta sauce

4 large cans of chicken or tuna

1 Taco Seasoning packet

2 cans of cream of chicken or cream of mushroom soup

6-pack of Ramen noodles

Bag of egg noodles

2 boxes of pasta

2 side dishes
(instant mashed potatoes or any “just add water” sides)
