Holy Land Trip - March 15-24, 2020

Itinerary Highlights*

The tour will take us to cities such as Caesarea, Megiddo, Nazareth, Cana, Capernaum, Tabgha, Hazor, Tel Dan, Caesarea Maratima, Beit Shean, Jericho, Gedi, Masada and Qumran.

We will visit famous biblical sites including Mt. Carmel, Sea of Galilee, Jordan River, Mt. of Beatitudes, Jordan Valley, Mt. of Temptation, Mt. of Olives, Garden of Gethsemane, Shepherd's Field and Church of the Nativity in Bethlehem and the Dead Sea.

There will be opportunities for a variety of unique activities including marriage vowel renewal in Cana, baptism in the Jordan River, a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee, the Palm Sunday Walk, and an opportunity for a time of private prayer in the Garden of Gethsemane.

We will also take in the sites of Jerusalem, starting with a special welcoming ceremony at Mt. Scopus. While in Jerusalem we will explore the Church of the Holy Sepulcher, Southern Wall excavations, the Western Wall, Rabbinic Tunnel, Pools of Bethesda, Mt. Zion, Jewish Quarter, Upper Room, and the Garden Tomb.

On our final day, we will visit the Israel Museum, Yad V'shem - The World Holocaust Remembrance Center and Machane Yehudah open-air market.
