- 5. There are over 300 prophesies about Christ coming to this world. How does this encourage you in view of our world's situation and the second coming of Christ?
- 6. God is never further than a thought or prayer away. Has this been evident in a particular circumstance that you have recently experienced?
- 7. God broke the silence by sending Jesus Christ as "redeeming grace" for every person. Have you experienced that "redeeming grace"?
