Starter Questions

Into the Word.

1. READ HEBREWS 10:22-25

Why does the author of Hebrews warn readers about neglecting to meet together? What benefits of meeting together are mentioned? During seasons when you have been unable to meet together, what did you miss the most?

2. READ ACTS 2:1, 42-47

How did the early church experience community? How do you see the church of today practicing community? How are they similar or different?

Into the Word.

3. READ ACTS 2:5-12

How did the miracle of Pentecost demonstrate the power of the unified church? Because they were together, all the believers experienced the miracle of speaking in unlearned foreign languages. The work of God through the church was echoed farther, louder and longer. How do you think God is working through our church today to show His glory to our community all around us?

4. PETER DENIES JESUS

Peter denied Jesus when he was alone, but beginning with Acts 2:14, notice how Peter proclaimed him openly and boldly as he was surrounded by fellow believers. How might you account for such a transformation?

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Application.


1. What benefits do you derive personally by being consistent in gathering with the church? What personal challenges or obstacles keep you from gathering together with believers regularly and how might you overcome those obstacles?

2. How has God used the church to support and encourage you in the past, and how did that help to sustain you? Who needs your support and encouragement today? How can God use you to help sustain someone in your group or in the church?

3. What does Peter's boldness teach us about the benefit of community? How can gathering together support and encourage you to use your story and your talents to share the hope of Jesus in your sphere of influence?
