Week Three: Moses and Aaron

- **Main Scripture:** Ecclesiastes 4:9; Exodus 4:10-17; 1 Peter 4:8
- **Bottom Line:** Friends cover our weaknesses.

Week Four: Paul and Timothy

- **Main Scripture:** Philippians 4:9; 1 Timothy 1:18-19; 1 Corinthians 4:15-16
- **Bottom Line:** Friends encourage us in our faith.

Week Five: Ruth and Naomi

- **Main Scripture:** Proverbs 27:9; Ruth 1:16-17; Romans 15:1-3
- **Bottom Line:** Friends walk through pain with you.
