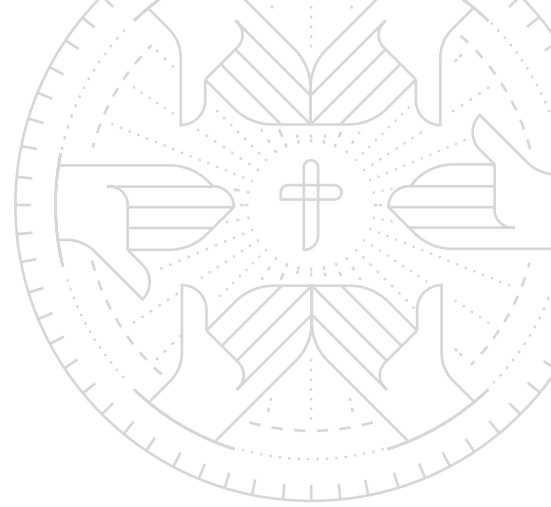

If you're interested in becoming a covenant member of Fairhaven Church attending this small group experience is your first step.



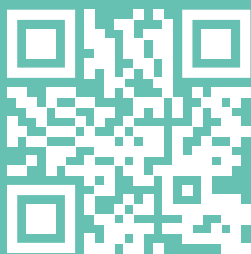

Young Adults

Men's Basketball

We begin in September with open gym on Thursday nights and form teams for an intramural league. Players register for the league individually and teams are formed by draft, although we do let friends play together.

Coed Volleyball

Our intramural, coed volleyball league plays on Thursday nights and begins in February. It's mostly for fun, but we do play by high school rules. Players register individually and are drafted to teams, although we do let couples and friends play together.

Family Life

A group for parents raising children. We meet twice monthly, Sept-May. The 1st Wednesdays we meet on campus at 6:30 PM for dinner, small group discussion/biblical teaching with speakers, and fellowship. The 3rd Wednesday is for outside family small group connection time. Childcare available 6 weeks - Kindergarten and Kids Program available 1st-5th grade with a one-week advance notice.
