Series Overview

Waiting can be hard. Whether we're waiting on a person, a circumstance, or waiting on God, waiting seasons come with a particular set of challenges -- but God is working even while we wait. This four-week series dives into four different waiting seasons in Scripture. Through the stories of Abraham, Hannah, the parable of the servants, and the prodigal son, we see how God's plan plays out specifically in seasons of waiting, and how we can honor and obey Him along the way.

Week One:

- **Main Scripture:** Psalm 27:14; Genesis 12:1-3, 15:1-6, 17:1-8, 18:1-10, 21:1-2; Hebrews 6:13-15
- **Bottom Line:** Waiting on God is worth it. Don't give up.

Week Two:

- **Main Scripture:** Jeremiah 29:13; 1 Samuel 1:1-19; Luke 11:9
- **Bottom Line:** Waiting on God is active, not passive.

Week Three:

- **Main Scripture:** Proverbs 13:4; Matthew 25:14-30; Colossians 3:23-24
- **Bottom Line:** Work your wait, don't waste it.

Week Four:

- **Main Scripture:** Isaiah 30:18; Luke 15:11-22; Acts 22:16
- **Bottom Line:** God is waiting for you.

Wait patiently for the Lord. Be brave and courageous. Yes, wait patiently for the Lord.
