- **Bottom Line:** Jesus is our protector and provider.

Week Three: The Servant

- **Main Scripture:** Mark 10:45; Philippians 2:5-8; John 13:12-17
- **Bottom Line:** Jesus is a humble servant.

Week Four: The Teacher

- **Main Scripture:** Matthew 23:10; John 14:5-6; John 17:17
- **Bottom Line:** Jesus is the source of truth.
