- Main Scripture: 1 Corinthians 14:33; Matthew 11:28-30; Philippians 4:6-7
- Bottom Line: Jesus brings peace in place of chaos.

### Week Three: Joy

- Main Scripture: Psalm 34:17-20; James 1:2-4; 1 Peter 5:7
- Bottom Line: Jesus brings joy in place of despair.
