

#### INTRODUCTION

What is one thing that stands out to you from Pastor David's message?

Proverbs 11:1-6 highlights the importance of living a life of integrity, aligning our words and actions with God's truth. Integrity is not just a personal standard but a reflection of God's character in us. So important! Unlike hypocrisy, which says one thing and does another, integrity brings humility, blessing, and truth into our lives. #### INTO THE WORD

**Read 2 Timothy 3:16-17.** How does this passage describe the Scriptures and their role in our everyday life? What is the outcome for a person who gives attention to God's Word?

**Read Micah 6:8 and Galatians 5:22-23.** What are some of the character traits mentioned in these verses? What are some other character traits that are important to you?

#### **APPLICATION**


How can your group support and encourage one another in pursuing greater integrity?
