

#### **INTRODUCTION**

This Easter, we were reminded that Jesus is the perfect picture of God. Through His life, death, and resurrection, Jesus shows us who God is: not distant, not harsh, but full of grace, truth, and love. Easter points us back to the reality that Jesus changes everything.

## **INTO THE WORD**

**Read Colossians 1:15, John 1:18, and Hebrews 1:3.** How does knowing that Jesus is the 'visible image of the invisible God' impact the way you see God?

**Read Acts 17:27, Psalm 145:18, and James 4:8.** When have you most felt that God was near to you? What made that experience meaningful? How should this truth impact the way we live?

**Read Romans 3:23-24, Ephesians 2:4-5, and 2 Corinthians 5:17.** What does it mean to you personally that Jesus didn't just come to make you better, but to make you alive?


**Read Mark 2:17, Isaiah 1:18, and Luke 15:17-24.** Why do you think people sometimes feel they need to 'clean up' their lives before coming to God? How does Jesus' invitation challenge that thinking?

**Read Romans 6:23, Ephesians 2:8-9, and Titus 3:4-7.** What makes it hard for people to accept salvation as a gift instead of something they have to earn?

- Which 'picture' of God (Judge, Accountant, Waste Manager, Gift Giver) do you most relate to and why? People connect differently: some need assurance of forgiveness, others need to experience God's nearness. Discussion will vary.
- Memorize Psalm 46:1 "God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble".
- How can you live differently knowing that God's grace is a gift, not something you have to earn?
