Series Overview

The Israelites had been living in Egypt for over four hundred years. They were slaves under the Pharaoh. They cried out for freedom, wondering if God had forgotten them. But God heard every cry for help. In a display of power and glory, God delivered His people from slavery!

Week One: On Holy Ground

- **Main Scripture:** Exodus 3:2-14; John 8:24
- **Bottom Line:** Although God is holy, He draws us into His presence.

Week Two: Let My People Go

- **Main Scripture:** Exodus 5:1-2; Exodus 7:4-7; Exodus 12:5-7,11-13,30-32
- **Bottom Line:** Deliverance requires us to trust in God's plans.

Week Three: The Lord Will Fight For You

- **Main Scripture:** Exodus 14:10-14, 21-31; Romans 6:23
- **Bottom Line:** Deliverance from God often looks different than what we expect.

Week Four: Bread From Heaven

- **Main Scripture:** Exodus 16:2-5, 8-20; John 3:16
- **Bottom Line:** Worship and trust are right responses to God's provision.

Week Five: They Will Bear It With You

- **Main Scripture:** Exodus 17:8-16; Exodus 18:17-23
- **Bottom Line:** We need community and encouragement from other believers.
