Projects may include, but are not limited to, remodeling an existing home by painting, repairing the floors and walls, hanging dry walls, replacing doors and windows, putting up vinyl siding, yard work, cleaning, or building wheelchair ramps.

Necessary Skills: Nothing required but a willing heart! All supplies & training are provided.
