Series Overview

Across four weeks, students learn that God guides us in how to love, calls us to worship Him alone, provides His presence through the tabernacle, and offers forgiveness through Jesus—the ultimate sacrifice who invites us into God’s holiness.

Week One: By the Finger of God

- **Main Scripture:** Exodus 20:1-21; Matthew 5:17
- **Bottom Line:** How we love God affects the way we love others.

Week Two: Make Gods For Us

- **Main Scripture:** Exodus 32:1-14, Psalm 103:8
- **Bottom Line:** We’re made to worship God alone.

Week Three: The Glory of the Lord

- **Main Scripture:** Exodus 40:1-17, 34-38; Matthew 1:23
- **Bottom Line:** Although God is holy, He makes a way for us to come into His presence.

Week Four: Atonement for All Their Sins

- **Main Scripture:** Leviticus 16:1-6, 15-22; Hebrews 10:4, 10
- **Bottom Line:** We depend on Jesus’s sacrifice to enter God’s holy presence.
