- **Bottom Line:** God will hold us accountable for our disobedience.

- **Main Scripture:** Joshua 10:1-15; Romans 8:3-4
- **Bottom Line:** God's power is evident in impossible situations.

- **Main Scripture:** Joshua 24:14-25; John 4:23
- **Bottom Line:** True worship can't happen without our obedience.
