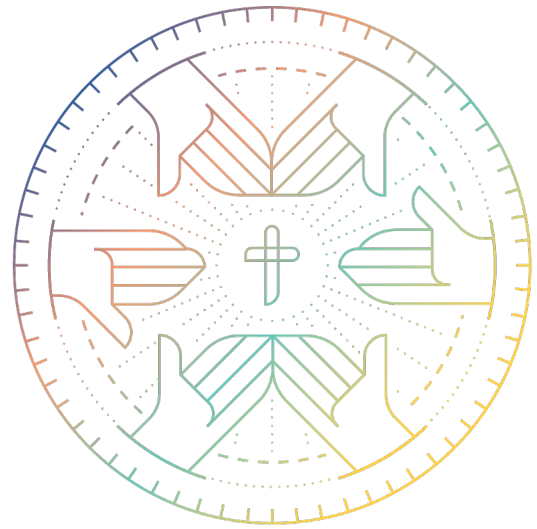

Every Day Matters: “Global Impact: Everyone to Everywhere”  
Scripture Focus: Acts 13:1-3

## ICEBREAKER

If you could experience daily life in another country or culture for a month, where would you go and why?

When you think about people who have never heard about Jesus, what thoughts or emotions come to mind?

## INTRODUCTION

God’s heart has always been for the nations—that every person, in every place, would know Him. In Acts 13:1–3, we see a diverse group of believers worshiping and praying together, and from that place of surrender, the Holy Spirit sends them out. This reminds us that mission doesn’t start with activity—it starts with worship. As we grow in our understanding of who Jesus is, our lives begin to align with what matters most to Him. The call to “everyone to everywhere” is not just for a few—it’s an invitation for all of us to surrender our everyday lives for God’s global purpose.

## INTO THE WORD

**Read Acts 13:1–3 and John 17:24.** What stands out about the posture of the church before they were sent? How does worship shape our willingness to join in what matters to Jesus?

**Read Romans 10:14–15 and Acts 1:8.** What do these passages reveal about the urgency and responsibility of sharing the Gospel? Where do you see yourself in this process?

**Read Acts 13:1 and Galatians 3:28.** Why is diversity in the church essential to God’s mission? How does unity in Christ strengthen our witness to the world?

**Read Matthew 9:37–38 and Isaiah 6:8.** How do these passages shape your understanding of the need to be missional? What might God be inviting you to surrender in your everyday life so that everyone everywhere can hear the Gospel?

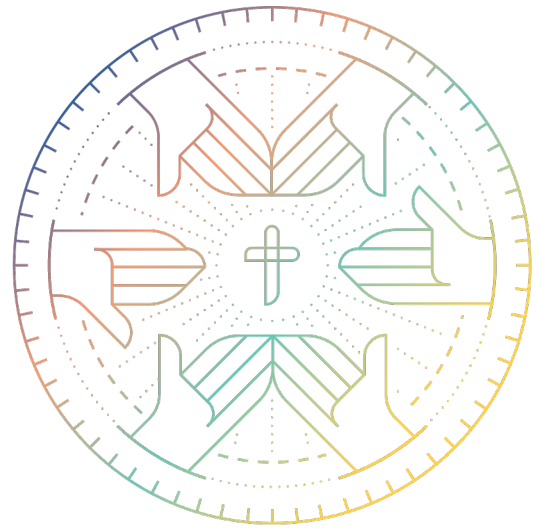
## EMBRACE AND EMBODY

## TAKE YOUR NEXT RIGHT STEP

- **Seek God Daily:** Begin praying daily about how God might use you to reach others.
- **Live Generously:** Look for an opportunity this week to serve a neighbor who may not know Jesus. As the Spirit leads, intentionally share your faith with them.
- **Make God Known:** Commit to praying regularly for those who are unreached in the Asia Pacific region.
