



Series Overview

This four-week series traces Israel's collapse as pride fuels division, idolatry replaces devotion, and God's people waver between truth and compromise. Yet even in rebellion, God pursues His people with truth that confronts and mercy that restores. Ultimately, we see how humility and repentance point us to Christ, the faithful King who brings redemption where sin once ruled.

Week One: The King Did Not Listen

- **Main Scripture:** 1 Kings 12:1-19
- **Bottom Line:** The advice we choose to follow can make a lasting impact on us and on those around us.

Week Two: Evil In The Lord's Sight

- **Main Scripture:** 1 Kings 12:25-33; 14:21-26
- **Bottom Line:** Idolatry leads us to imitate the world around us instead of Christ.

Week Three: How Long Will You Waver?

- **Main Scripture:** 1 Kings 18:20-26, 30-39
- **Bottom Line:** When we confront our idols, we'll see they are powerless to save us.

Week Four: He Has Humbled Himself

- **Main Scripture:** 1 Kings 21:17-29
- **Bottom Line:** Humility is an important step in restoring a broken relationship with God.
