Series Overview

- **Bottom Line:** Even when our faithfulness is risky, God is able to deliver us.

Week Three: Into the Lions' Den

- **Main Scripture:** Daniel 6:7-18,19-24
- **Bottom Line:** Even when we suffer for our faith, God remains with us.

Week Four: An Everlasting Dominion

- **Main Scripture:** Daniel 7:1-14
- **Bottom Line:** Even when worldly kingdoms fall, God's kingdom lasts forever.
